Choose hardwoods like oak or walnut for durability, or tempered glass for a lighter, modern look.

Seating that matches

Allow 24 inches per seat for comfort and consider extendable designs for hosting flexibility.

Lifestyle compatibility

Families with young kids may prefer easy-toclean finishes; entertainers may opt for spacious surfaces.

Style that blends

Match the table's finish and form with your existing decor, whether rustic, contemporary, or transitional.
